Position Summary

We require a highly professional and personable LPN who demonstrates clear and concise communication, organization scale, and enjoys working with patients and healthcare team members.

The musculoskeletal nurse is responsible for health information screening, consenting patient prior to procedure, execute blood draws, Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) preparation, safely positioning patients, assisting physician with drawing medications and injection, cleaning exam/injection room, reconciling payments, and stocking medical supplies in compliance with health, safety and clinic policies.



The musculoskeletal nurse will receive ongoing one-on-one training to be able to perform clinical tasks and address patients' questions and concerns regarding consents, injection, and related medical topics.

- Scheduling procedure appointments
- Managing patient callbacks, questions, emails, and concerns
- Reviewing contraindications, and consenting patients prior to procedure
- Escorting and positioning patients, pre-and post-procedure assessments
- Performing blood draws, PRP preparation, and assist with drawing medication
- Assist with the sterile technique and radiofrequency ablation procedure
- Investigate and manage patient records on EMR and Netcare
- Billing invoices, receiving and reconciling payments
- Running injection clinic, cleaning, and stocking medical supplies
